

## **Postoperative instructions** Open Reduction Internal Fixation Patella Fracture

Weightbearing: Weightbearing as tolerated to the operative extremity in brace. You MUST wear your knee immobilizer brace at all times! This needs to be centered over the kneecap to work effectively

Dressing instructions: Keep your dressing clean and dry at all times. You may change your dressing on Post-operative day #5 (Monday).

Pain control: You have been given a prescription to be taken as directed for post-operative pain control. In addition, elevate the operative extremity above the heart at all times to prevent swelling and throbbing pain.

Take over-the-counter Colace, 100mg by mouth twice a day while taking narcotic pain medications to help prevent constipation.

Please call 931-552-4340 for any problems. Including the following:

- Excessive redness of the incisions
- Drainage for more than 4 days
- Fever of more than 101.5° F

Please call 931-552-4340 if you do not receive or are unsure of your first follow-up appointment. You should have an appointment 10-14 days after your surgery.

Follow up appointments:

- 1) 10-14 days for suture removal and wound check
- 2) Dr. Teske 6 weeks for X-Rays
